

## Results of Hand Count and Early Voting Audit

February 5, 2008

Presidential Preference Election (PPE)

On February 6, 2008 at 1:00pm, Coconino County Elections started the hand recount process according to ARS 16-602C. The participating political parties were Republican, Democrat and Libertarian. Two polling locations were selected by lot as required. Each board consisting of four members were registered voters in Coconino County and were equally divided per political party representation.


The polling locations selected was **District 1** and **District 18**. The decision was made by the County Recorder/Officer in charge of Elections and the hand recount board to audit both the Democrat and Republican Presidential Candidate races for **both** precincts. The hand recount and early voting audit was finished on February 7, 2008 by 12:00pm.
