Results of Hand Count and Early Voting Audit
November 4, 2008 General Election

On November 5, 2008 at 1:00pm, Coconino County Elections started the hand count process according to ARS 16-602C. The participating political parties were Republican, Democrat and Libertarian. Two polling precincts were selected by lot as required. Each board consisting of four members were registered voters in the state of Arizona and were equally divided per political party representation.

The polling precincts selected were Fort **Tuthill (#54)** and **Page West (#75)**. The hand count and early voting audit was finished on November 6, 2008 at 3:30pm. Below is listed the races selected to be counted and the summary of the results:

RACES TO BE COUNTED (5)

Presidential Elector
Corporation Commission
Proposition 101
US Representative- CD1
State Legislative- Senator

For both Precincts, Fort Tuthill and Page West the total number of ballots cast in the precincts and the hand count total for every candidate in each race listed above the hand count total matched the machine total (**100% match**).

EARLY BALLOT AUDIT

Based on the early ballot estimates there were 8 batches created consisting of 100 ballots each. The number of total early ballots cast in Coconino was just over 24,000; therefore, accordingly 3 batches were needed to audit to insure the 1% random sample. Batches 1, 2, and 7 were audited and also matched the machine totals (**100% matches**).
