**THE FULL AND CORRECT COPY OF THE TITLE AND TEXT OF THE PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS:**

**The original title and text of the Article II, Section 4 of the Arizona Constitution, read as:**

**§ 4. Due process of law**

Section 4. No person shall be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law.

**Description**

1. A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 4 OF THE ARIZONA CONSTITUTION RELATING TO THE RIGHT OF DUE PROCESS FOR ALL CITIZENS OF THIS STATE, BY ADDING THE EQUAL PROTECTION OF THE LAWS CLAUSE OF SECTION 1 OF THE AMENDMENT XIV OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION TO ELIMINATE STATE DISCRIMINATION.

**The proposed amendment to Article II, section 4 of the Arizona Constitution:**

**§ 4. Due process of law; EQUAL PROTECTION OF THE LAWS**

Section 4. No person BORN OR NATURALIZED WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE UNITED STATES shall be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law; NOR DENY TO ANY CITIZEN WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THIS STATE, THE EQUAL PROTECTION OF THE LAWS.
