ARIZONA PHOTO ENFORCEMENT ACT

AN INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

TEXT OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Arizona; Amending the Constitution of Arizona; by adding Article XXXI; relating to the "Arizona Photo Enforcement Act"

Be it enacted by the People of Arizona:

1. Article XXXI. Constitution of Arizona is proposed to be added as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the Governor:

Article XXXI. Arizona Photo Enforcement Act

Section 1. Arizona Photo Enforcement Act prohibits the use of photo enforcement devices except for within currently defined designated school crossing zones while school is in session.

2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters at the next general election as provided by Article XXI, Constitution of Arizona.
