THIS WOULD PROHIBIT POLITICIANS FROM HIDING BEHIND IMMUNITY LAWS IN REGARDS TO DUI'S, DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, POSTPONING TAX ISSUES WITH THE IRS, ETC. THEY WILL BE HELD TO THE SAME JUDICIAL STANDARDS AS THEIR CONSTITUENTS. THIS WOULD REQUIRE POLITICIANS TO OBEY THE LAWS OUTSIDE THE LEGISLATURE AND CARRY OUT THEIR DUTIES FOR THE PUBLIC GOOD, NOT FOR THEIR OWN PRIVATE INDULGENCES.
