PROCLAMATION

Calling a Special Primary and General Election for the Eighth Congressional District in Arizona

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2012, The Honorable Gabrielle Giffords resigned as a United States Representative for the Eighth Congressional District in Arizona and that office is officially declared vacant.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16-222(B) of the Arizona Revised Statutes, upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the office of representative in Congress, if the next general election is not to be held within six months from the date of the occurrence of the vacancy, the governor shall call a special primary election and a special general election to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Janice K. Brewer, Governor of the State of Arizona, by the power vested in me by Sections 16-221, 16-222 and 16-223 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, hereby proclaim and order the calling of a special primary election and a special general election in accordance with Arizona law for the purpose of filling the vacancy in the Eighth Congressional District in Arizona. The special primary election shall occur on April 17, 2012 and the special general election shall occur on June 12, 2012.
