Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 19-111, attached hereto is the full text, in no less than eight point type, of the **MEASURE** or **CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT** (circle appropriate word) intended to be **INITIATED** or **REFERRED** (circle appropriate word) at the next general election.

SUMMARY: A description of no more than one hundred words of the principal provisions of the proposed law, constitutional amendment or measure that will appear in no less than eight point type on the face of each petition signature sheet to be circulated.

The Protect Employee Paychecks from Politics Act ensures that money withdrawn from an employee's paycheck for political purposes is solely at the choice of the employee – never the employer or other entity.

It prohibits all employers in Arizona from taking money from an employee's paycheck and using it for political purposes without the express written permission of the employee.

AN INITIATIVE MEASURE

Protecting employee paychecks; Proposing an amendment to the Arizona Constitution by adding Article XXXI relating to Employee Paychecks

TEXT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Arizona:

Section 1. Title. This initiative measure shall be known as the Protect Employee Paychecks from Politics Act.

Section 2. The Arizona Constitution is amended by adding Article XXXI as follows:

Article XXXI. Employee Paychecks

A. ALL EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE OF ARIZONA SHALL BE FREE FROM ANY EMPLOYER DEDUCTING OR FACILITATING THE DEDUCTION OF MONEY FROM ANY EMPLOYEE'S PAYCHECK FOR POLITICAL PURPOSES, WITHOUT THE EXPRESS WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE EMPLOYEE. THE EMPLOYEE'S EXPRESS WRITTEN PERMISSION MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO ANY DEDUCTION AND MUST BE RENEWED NO LESS THAN ANNUALLY. THE EMPLOYEE MAY CANCEL A PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED DEDUCTION AT ANY TIME.

B. "POLITICAL PURPOSES" MEANS TO BE USED, EITHER DIRECTLY BY THE ENTITY RECEIVING THE DEDUCTED MONEY OR THROUGH A CONTRIBUTION BY THAT ENTITY TO A POLITICAL COMMITTEE OR OTHER ENTITY, FOR A CONTRIBUTION TO A CANDIDATE, OR AN EXPENDITURE IN SUPPORT OF OR OPPOSITION TO A CANDIDATE, SLATE OF CANDIDATES, POLITICAL PARTY, REFERENDUM OR INITIATIVE OR TO SUPPORT OR OPPOSE PENDING OR POTENTIAL LEGISLATION.

C. SHOULD ANY PART OF THE PROTECT EMPLOYEE PAYCHECKS FROM POLITICS ACT BE RULED OR DECLARED INVALID THE REMAINING PORTIONS SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

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
