Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 19-111, attached hereto is the full text, in no less than eight point type, of the MEASURE or CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT (circle appropriate word) intended to be INITIATED or REFERRED (circle appropriate word) at the next general election.

SUMMARY: A description of no more than one hundred words of the principal provisions of the proposed law, constitutional amendment or measure that will appear in no less than eight point type on the face of each petition signature sheet to be circulated.

This measure will define marriage in Arizona as being a union of two persons. It will ensure the protection of religious freedoms by specifying that religious organizations, religious associations, and religious societies in Arizona will not be required to solemnize or officiate any particular marriage or religious rite of marriage.

AN INITIATIVE MEASURE

DEFINING MARRIAGE AS A UNION OF TWO PERSONS; PROTECTING FREEDOM OF RELIGION BY SPECIFYING THAT RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO SOLEMNIZE OR OFFICIATE ANY PARTICULAR MARRIAGE OR RELIGIOUS RITE OF MARRIAGE; PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE XXX OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA RELATING TO MARRIAGE

TEXT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Arizona:

ARTICLE XXX. MARRIAGE

1. Marriage

Section 1. Only a union of ~~one man and one woman~~ **TWO PERSONS** shall be valid or recognized as a marriage in this state.

SECTION 2. A RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION, RELIGIOUS ASSOCIATION, OR RELIGIOUS SOCIETY SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO SOLEMNIZE OR OFFICIATE ANY PARTICULAR MARRIAGE OR RELIGIOUS RITE OF MARRIAGE IN VIOLATION OF ITS CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO FREE EXERCISE OF RELIGION.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

IF ANY PROVISION OF THIS INITIATIVE IS HELD INVALID FOR ANY REASON, THE REMAINING PORTIONS OF THIS INITIATIVE WILL BE SEVERED FROM THE VOID PORTION AND GIVEN THE FULLEST POSSIBLE FORCE AND APPLICATION. THE PEOPLE OF ARIZONA DECLARE THEIR INTENTION THAT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS INITIATIVE ARE SEVERABLE.

SECTION 4. SUBMISSION TO VOTERS

THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SUBMIT THIS PROPOSITION TO THE VOTERS AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION AS PROVIDED BY ARTICLE XXI, SECTION 1, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA.
