

**NOTICES OF TERMINATED RULEMAKING
Initiated After January 1, 1995**

Terminated Rules: An agency shall terminate a proposed rulemaking if the agency does not wish to permanently adopt the rule. Within 120 days after publication of the notice of proposed rulemaking in the *Register* or after the close of the record for the proposed rule, whichever is later, an agency shall either adopt the rule and submit it to the Governor's Regulatory Review Council or the Attorney General for approval or terminate the rule by filing a Notice of Termination with the Secretary of State. A.R.S. § 41-1024.
