Responsibility is established for monitoring drug expiration dates, deterioration, damage to containers, illegible labels, and accountability and security of the drug box and its contents. The process for authority notification is detailed when discrepancies of contents are found. Guidelines are provided for approval of an appropriate device for conveying approved drugs. Current drugs approved for administration by certified paramedics and intermediate emergency technicians are listed.
