

## NOTICES OF FORMAL RULEMAKING ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the publication of Notices of Formal Rulemaking Advisory Committees whenever an agency appoints a committee before the agency submits a proposed rulemaking to the Secretary of State's Office for publication in the Register. Membership of the committee shall be published at the time of formation and shall be published in the Register annually.
