This rulemaking will adopt a new Section, R18-4-224, establishing interim monitoring relief for monitoring of synthetic organic chemicals (SOCs) for public water systems serving 10,000 or fewer persons. The rule provides that, after an initial monitoring which fails to detect the presence of SOCS in the the ground or surface water supplying the public water system, additional quarterly monitoring for those contaminants is not required, during the interim relief period.
The Department might also find it necessary to revise the definitions in R18-4-201 to clarify terms used in R18-4-224.
