1. **Title and its heading:** 17, Transportation

2. **The subject matter of the proposed rule:**

R17-4-240 prescribes the amount of bond required for automobile dealer license applicants and automotive recycler license applicants. There was a statutory change in 1991 and the rule must be amended to reflect those changes.

R17-4-250 establishes a 1973 license plate as valid if a 1974 reflectorized sticker is attached. The rule is obsolete and will be repealed.

R17-4-251 requires a \$5.00 fee for a horseless carriage or classic car license plate. The rule does not conform to statute and will be repealed.

R17-4-252 provides for the issuance of "no fee" vehicle plates to vehicles owned by the State and political subdivisions thereof. The rule will be amended to reflect that the plates are of permanent duration rather than 5 year.

R17-4-260 provides standards for the title transfer of a vehicle repossessed because of nonpayment. The rule will be amended to conform with current Division policy as to form and fees.

R17-4-265 establishes a minimum value for vehicles for purpose of transfer tax. It will be repealed.

R17-4-406 designates state routes restricted as to maximum vehicle/vehicle load width. The rule will be amended to improve clarity, conciseness, and understandability.

R17-4-420 requires private carriers to leave a copy of manifest or delivery instructions at port of entry. It will be repealed.
