

## NOTICES OF RULEMAKING DOCKET OPENING

The subject matter in Article 1 deals with public participation in rulemaking, and governs the process by which agency rules are developed and become effective. Article 2 authorizes the Department to set off sums owed to it out of lottery winnings and state tax refunds, and describes the rights of a person whose debt was set off to file for, and receive, a review of the setoff. Article 3 prescribes the conditions under which a Department-licensed provider may employ a person who has committed prior criminal acts. Article 4 enables the Department to do criminal history checks on persons who provide unsupervised services to children. Article 5 states the Department's policy on nondiscrimination, in compliance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The Department will accept written comments from now until the close of record, which has not yet been scheduled, to the person named in question 4. The Department will schedule oral proceedings at the time of filing the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.

The Department expects to file a proposed rule amendment with the Secretary of State's Office in December, 1998. The Department will accept written, public comments for at least 30 days after publication of the proposed rules. The Department will conduct a public hearing on the proposed rules approximately 1 month after publication of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking. The Department will then close the record and proceed to the Governor's Regulatory Review Council as expeditiously as possible.

On August 22, 1996, the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 became effective. This legislation made significant changes to the distribution and disbursement of child support in Title IV-D child support cases. This rule implements these distribution changes. These changes took effect on October 1, 1997 and have been applied to payments with receipt dates of October 1, 1997 and later. This legislation requires states to start tracking temporarily assigned arrearages on October 1, 1997. In addition, the legislation provides a three year phase-in period from October 1997 to September 2000. Temporarily assigned arrearage payments to the family will be delayed until October 1, 2000. In addition, the rule contains a process for a custodial person to request an administrative review of the disbursement of support.
