ARTICLE 7. INSTRUCTION, FACULTY, AND STAFF

**R7-1-710. Open Entry, Open Exit Courses**

A. All open entry, open exit courses offered by a community college district shall comply with the provisions of R7-1-701(B), be approved by the State Board.

1. ~~In order to obtain State Board approval, the courses shall meet the following standards:~~
  - a. ~~Courses must be competency based.~~
  - b. ~~Courses must be planned to meet the needs of an identified occupational area.~~
  - c. ~~Courses must include an emphasis on laboratory training.~~
  - d. ~~Courses must commence at various times throughout the fiscal year.~~
2. ~~In addition, the community college district shall demonstrate the following on forms provided by the State Board:~~
  - a. ~~Teachers must be appropriately certified.~~
  - b. ~~Job placement services must be provided.~~
  - c. ~~Information from former students regarding satisfaction with courses and job placement.~~

- d. ~~Adequate equipment and facilities for each course must be available.~~
- e. ~~Program evaluation must be included.~~
- f. ~~Course content must be designed to assist students in one or more of the following areas:~~
  - i. ~~The course prepares students for employment.~~
  - ii. ~~The course prepares students for advanced vocational programs.~~
  - iii. ~~The course upgrades skills of persons already employed.~~
- g. ~~Local advisory committees appointed annually by each community college district shall be utilized for at least the following purposes:~~
  - i. ~~Review of competencies.~~
  - ii. ~~Providing expertise as it relates to equipment, facilities and placement.~~
- h. ~~Students should be enrolled on the basis of career intent.~~
- i. ~~Equal access is provided to minorities, women and handicapped.~~

**B.** Each open entry, open exit course shall have clearly defined and measurable competencies.

**BC.** The State Board may periodically review all open entry, open exit courses classified as open entry/open exit, pursuant to A and B of this rule.
