2. The subject matter of the proposed rule:

The purpose of this rulemaking is for the Department to repeal R9-1-101 through R9-1-117, R9-1-119, and R9-1-121 because the Department no longer has statutory authority to hold hearings. The Legislature has granted that authority to the Office of Administrative Hearings, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.01. The Department will also repeal R9-1-118 and R9-1-120, and will add 3 new sections. In one new section the Department will provide definitions for the chapter. Another new section will contain criteria for parties to follow, if they wish to object to the decision on an appealable agency action, made by an administrative law judge. In the 3rd new section the Department will provide criteria for those parties to follow who wish to request a review or rehearing of that decision. The new sections will comply with current statutes and conform to current rulemaking format and style requirements. The Department will also amend R9-1-202 through R9-1-206, to conform to current rulemaking format and style requirements. The Department will repeal R9-1-311, R9-1-312, and R9-1-314, and will add 2 new sections that provide definitions, and specify under what circumstances and for what purposes medical information may be released by the Department. Finally, the Department will repeal R9-1-313 and R9-1-315, as they contain information that is not properly contained in rules.
