The rule provides that the ADOT Motor Vehicle Division issue without registration fees motor vehicle plates to vehicles owned by the State of Arizona and its political subdivisions. The plates were to be issued for a 5-year period without a year designation. The rule was adopted in 1973 and neither reflects the underlying statute A.R.S. § 28-2511 nor the Division's current practices relative to plate issuance for state-owned vehicles. The rulemaking arises from proposed agency action in the 5-year review report (F-98-0401) approved by the Governor's Regulatory Review Council on May 5, 1998. The rule's amendment will also incorporate the statutory requirements of both GRRC and the Secretary of State.
