

NOTICES OF SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS

The Administrative Procedure Act requires the publication of substantive policy statements issued by agencies (A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(14)). Substantive Policy Statements are written expressions which inform the general public of an agency's current approach to rule or regulation practice. Substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents which may only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties in accordance with A.R.S. Title 41.

A.R.S. § 32-144(A)(6) states that a non-registrant may design a water or wastewater treatment plant, or extensions, additions, modifications, or revisions or extensions to water distribution or collection systems, if the total cost of such construction does not exceed twelve thousand five hundred dollars. The Board has interpreted the "total cost of such construction" to not include fees for permits or registration, costs for maintenance, or costs for purchase of lands. The costs shall be those for services normally performed by a designer and a contractor.
