

**EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS OF
GENERAL APPLICABILITY, AND STATEMENTS
ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR
PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)**

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, a state of emergency was declared on August 25, 2000, for the intense wind storm that caused extensive damage to many homes and County infrastructure throughout Mohave County; and

WHEREAS, all of the eligible response and recovery work pertaining to the emergency has been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Emergency Funds were expended pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-192, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jane Dee Hull, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, do hereby terminate the declaration of the state of emergency of August 25, 2000. All unexpended funds allocated to the emergency shall revert to the Governor's Emergency Fund.
