The Retailer rules prescribes the requirements and procedures for Arizona retail businesses to obtain a license to sell Lottery game products, display promotional materials, requirements for the sale and payment of instant games and on-line games, and retailer conduct. The rules establish procedures for revocation, suspension or renewal of retailer licenses, hearing procedures and Lottery conducted compliance investigations. This amendment will establish penalties, required by legislative changes to the Lottery statute, for the sale of a Lottery ticket to a person under the age of 18 or to a person who uses a public assistance voucher or an electronic benefits card to purchase the ticket.
