A new Section R4-23-675 Limited-service Sterile Pharmaceutical Products Pharmacy will describe specific requirements for a limited-service sterile pharmaceutical products pharmacy. The amended rules will include format, style, and grammar changes necessary to comply with the current Administrative Procedure Act.

New R9-6-708 will include the information previously found in R9-6-707. In addition to the changes made to make the rules clear, concise, and understandable, R9-6-702 will provide for the notification of vaccine shortages, R9-6-706 will add Hepatitis A to the list of reportable vaccinations, and R9-6-707 will add the federal Women, Infants, and Children program to the list of authorized individuals, organizations, and agencies that are allowed access to immunization information from the ASIIS registry.
