

NOTICES OF RECODIFICATION

When the Secretary of State's Office finds it necessary to recodify a Chapter in order to maintain the integrity of the codification system or whenever an agency requests, in writing, that the Office recodify an entire Chapter or portion of a Chapter, the Office will publish a Notice of Recodification in the *Register*.
