

NOTICES OF TERMINATION OF RULEMAKING

Terminated Rules: An agency shall terminate a proposed rulemaking if the agency does not wish to adopt the rule. Within 120 days after publication of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the *Register* or after the close of the record for the proposed rule, the agency may terminate the rule by filing a Notice of Termination with the Secretary of State (A.R.S. § 41-1024).
