In R9-1-412, the Department incorporates by reference health and safety codes and standards for physical plants. The Department does this in R9-1-412 so that the Department can refer to R9-1-412 in its licensure rules within Title 9 rather than including separate incorporations by reference in each set of licensure rules. In R9-1-411, the Department provides rules of construction to resolve conflicts occurring between or among the standards incorporated by reference in R9-1-412 and the standards adopted within the narrative language of Sections within Title 9. Currently, R9-1-412 also includes requirements for correction of deficiencies resulting from violations of standards incorporated by reference in R9-1-412.

In this rulemaking, the Department intends to clarify the rules of construction for conflicts occurring between or among the standards incorporated by reference in R9-1-412 and the standards adopted within the narrative language of Sections within Article 9. The Department also intends to remove from R9-1-411 the requirements for correction of deficiencies resulting from violations of standards incorporated by reference in R9-1-412, which the Department intends to move to 9 A.A.C. 10, Article 1. The Department may add, delete, or modify additional Sections as necessary.
