The Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division (Division) proposes to amend the motor carrier financial responsibility rules. The Division is updating the rules so they are consistent with the 1997 revision of Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 28. Additionally, the Division is making the rules more clear, concise, and understandable.

9. The summary of the economic, small business, and consumer impact:

A.R.S. § 28-4034(B) authorizes the Division to have a motor carrier certify its financial responsibility if the motor carrier operates a vehicle for a commercial purpose in Arizona that is:

- Over 20,000 pounds declared gross weight;
- Transporting hazardous material, substances, or waste, unless excluded by A.R.S. § 28-4032(A)(2); or
- Transporting passengers for hire, unless operated by a carpool operator defined in A.R.S. § 28-4032(B).

A.R.S. § 28-4034(B) also authorizes the Division to have a motor carrier's insurance company confirm the financial responsibility certified by the motor carrier. The legislature intended to have available to users of the Arizona roads injured by a commercial vehicle listed in the previous paragraph, compensation in the amounts stated in A.R.S. § 28-4033. McCandless v. United Southern Assurance Company, 191 Ariz. 167, 172, 953 P.2d 911(App. 1997).

The motor carrier financial responsibility rules, R17-5-504 through R17-5-507, originally effective in 1987, require filing of proof of financial responsibility with the Division for motor carriers operating certain types of commercial vehicles. A.R.S. § 28-4034(B), formerly A.R.S. § 28-1234, authorizes this filing requirement. The Division determined that placing the filing requirement on all operators of the commercial vehicles included in A.R.S. § 28-4032, with a limited exception for commercial vehicles in Arizona carrying commercial agricultural products within 25 miles of the border between Arizona and Mexico, best promotes motor carrier financial responsibility.

This revision of the motor carrier financial responsibility rules will not increase a motor carrier's or an insurance company's costs related to certifying or confirming the motor carrier's financial responsibility. This certification and confirmation is authorized by statute, and the Division determined that placing the filing requirement on all operators of the commercial vehicles included in A.R.S. § 28-4032 best promotes motor carrier financial responsibility.

The agency made non-substantial changes for conciseness and clarity by removing unneeded references, combining subsections, and making minor format changes upon recommendations made by the ADOT/MVD Administrative Rules Unit. Other non-substantial changes in grammar, syntax, and stylistics were made upon recommendations by Governor's Regulatory Review Council staff. Additionally, R17-5-505 was incorporated into R17-5-504, which required R17-5-505 to be changed to "Repealed." These additional changes were made for clarity at the recommendation of Governor's Regulatory Review Council staff.

ARTICLE 5. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

R17-5-501. Reserved Definitions

In this Article, unless the context otherwise requires:

1. "Binder" means a contract for temporary insurance as described in A.R.S. § 20-1120.
2. "Division" means the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division.
3. "Initial motor vehicle registration" means the first time a motor carrier registers a specific motor vehicle or a vehicle combination in Arizona.
4. "Insurance company" means an entity that is in the business of issuing motor carrier liability insurance policies.
5. "Lightweight motor vehicle" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-5201(6).
6. "Managing general agent" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 20-284(A).
7. "Motor carrier" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-5201(8).
8. "Motor vehicle" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-5201(9).
9. "Motor vehicle liability policy" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-4001(4).
10. "Proof of financial responsibility" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-4001(7).
11. "Vehicle combination" has the meaning in A.R.S. § 28-5431(3).

R17-5-504. Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility Requirement to Submit Proof of Financial Responsibility: Applicability and Procedure

A. Definitions:

1. ~~"Authorized representative" means any person who has written authorization from the insurance carrier to sign documents on behalf of the insurance carrier.~~
2. ~~"Certificate holder" or "Commission" means the Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division.~~
3. ~~"Commercial enterprise" means an activity carried on for gain or profit.~~
4. ~~"For hire" means the transportation of passengers in the furtherance of a commercial enterprise for which a specific rate or fee is charged as a condition to obtaining the service except for the following:~~
 - a. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by a church.~~
 - b. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by a non-profit school classified as tax exempt by the federal government and used exclusively for transporting passengers in connection with school functions.~~
 - c. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by any non-profit search and rescue organization that qualifies for exemption from gross weight fees under A.R.S. § 28-206.~~
 - d. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by a foreign government, federal government, state, political subdivision of a state, or an Indian tribal government.~~
 - e. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated privately and exclusively as school buses under contract to a school district.~~
 - f. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by organizations that qualify for exemption from taxation of income under A.R.S. § 43-1201.~~
 - g. ~~Motor vehicles owned and operated by a car pool operator as defined at A.R.S. § 28-101(9).~~
5. ~~Hazardous materials in the context of these rules has the same meaning as set forth in R17-5-209.~~
6. ~~"Insurance binder has the meaning prescribed in A.R.S. § 20-1120.~~
7. ~~"Insurance carrier means a business entity that enters into contracts to indemnify or guarantee persons subject to Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility against loss from specified contingencies.~~
8. ~~"Insured" means any person who is subject to and in compliance with the Motor Carrier financial Responsibility Act set forth at A.R.S. §§ 28-1231 et seq.~~
9. ~~"Producer" means any person, general agent, broker, or agent authorized to transact business on behalf of the insurance carrier.~~
10. ~~"Qualifier" means a specified contingency that the insurance carrier and the insured have agreed, and the Director of the Motor Vehicle Division has accepted will not be indemnified or guaranteed against loss.~~

B. General provisions:

1. ~~Every owner, lessor, or lessee operating a motor vehicle in the furtherance of a commercial enterprise with a declared gross vehicle weight in excess of 20,000 pounds or transporting hazardous materials, substances or wastes, regardless of gross vehicle weight, unless exempted by A.R.S. § 28-1232(B), or operating a passenger-carrying motor vehicle, bus, or van used to transport passengers for hire, and who is subject to registration pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 28-221, 28-225, 28-302 or 28-501 shall file with Motor Vehicle Division, proof of financial responsibility in amounts equal to or greater than the minimum amounts prescribed in A.R.S. § 28-1233.~~
2. ~~Every owner or lessor operating a motor vehicle that is subject to A.R.S. §§ 28-221, 28-225, 28-302, or 28-501 and that is tax licensed as defined under A.R.S. §§ 28-1559 or 28-1599.01 shall comply with the provisions of R17-5-505 or R17-5-506. If the owner or lessor is operating a motor vehicle that is not tax licensed under A.R.S. §§ 28-1559 or 28-1599.01, the owner or lessor shall comply with the provisions of R17-5-507.~~

3. Every owner, lessor, or lessee operating a light weight motor vehicle as defined in A.R.S. § 28-1599(3), registered pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 28-221 or 28-225, in a manner that makes the owner, lessor, or lessee subject to Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility shall comply with the provisions of R17-5-505 or R17-5-506.
 4. Insurance carriers that provide insurance to persons who are subject to Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility shall comply with the filing requirements set forth at R17-5-505, R17-5-506, or R17-5-507.
 5. The following documents, when issued by an insurance carrier or the insurance carrier's authorized representative, will be accepted by the Motor Vehicle Division as proof of financial responsibility:
 - a. Form E. Uniform Motor Carrier Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability Certificate of Insurance (see R17-5-505).
 - b. Form K. Uniform Notice of Cancellation of Motor Carrier Insurance Policies (see R17-5-505).
 - c. Certificate of Insurance (see R17-5-506 and R17-5-507).
 - d. Written 45-day notice of cancellation of Certificate of Insurance.
 6. The Motor Vehicle Division shall provide a conformed copy of any document filed by an insurance carrier as proof of financial responsibility to an insurance carrier that submits a copy of the document at the time that the original document is filed and a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- C.** Exemption. These rules do not apply to owners, lessors, or lessees who operate motor vehicles carrying agricultural products within 25 miles of the border between Arizona and Mexico.
- D.** Failure to comply. If the owner, lessor, or lessee of a motor vehicle is subject to Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility, the Motor Vehicle Division shall register the motor vehicle only if the owner, lessor, or lessee complies with A.R.S. § 28-1233 or 28-1235, and files proof of financial responsibility in accordance with R17-5-505 or R17-5-506.
- E.** Noncompliance:
1. The Motor Vehicle Division shall cancel the registration of a motor vehicle if the owner, lessor, or lessee of the motor vehicle, who is subject to Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility, permits insurance on the motor vehicle to be canceled.
 2. The Motor Vehicle Division shall reissue a registration for a motor vehicle for which the registration is canceled if the owner, lessor, or lessee of the motor vehicle:
 - a. Submits an insurance binder covering the motor vehicle to the Motor Vehicle Division, and
 - b. Filed a Form E prior to expiration of the insurance binder with the Motor Vehicle Division.
 3. If the owner, lessor, or lessee of the motor vehicle fails to comply with subsections (E)(2)(a) and (b), the Motor Vehicle Division shall cancel, without further notice, the reissued registration of the motor vehicle.
 4. Upon receipt of notice of insurance cancellation from an insurance carrier, the Motor Vehicle Division shall mail a certified letter to the insured, requiring the insured to provide proof of compliance with A.R.S. § 28-1233 to the Motor Vehicle Division on or before the date on which the insurance cancellation becomes effective.
 5. The Motor Vehicle Division shall cancel the registration and number plate of the motor vehicle owned or operated by a person who is required, but fails to comply with A.R.S. § 28-1233 regarding the motor vehicle or who fails to respond to the Motor Vehicle Division's request for proof of compliance with A.R.S. § 28-1233.
- A.** If a motor carrier under A.R.S. § 28-4032 does not insure its motor vehicle or vehicle combination by an insurance company that reports to the Division under A.R.S. § 28-4148, R17-5-502, or R17-5-503, the motor carrier shall submit proof of financial responsibility as prescribed in this Section, and in the amount required under A.R.S. § 28-4033(A), as follows:
1. At the time of initial motor vehicle registration, or
 2. As notified by the Division under R17-5-506.
- B.** An insurance company, its managing general agent, broker, or agent may submit, on behalf of a motor carrier, proof of financial responsibility to the Division.
- C.** As proof of financial responsibility, a motor carrier shall submit the original or photocopy of:
1. A valid liability insurance policy;
 2. A binder dated within 90 days of filing with the Division;
 3. A completed and signed Form E Uniform Motor Carrier Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability Certificate of Insurance listed in subsection (E), naming the Arizona Department of Transportation as the Commission;
 4. A completed and signed Certificate of Liability Insurance form listed in subsection (F) naming the Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division as the certificate holder; or
 5. A certificate of self-insurance issued by the Division after a motor carrier meets the requirements of A.R.S. §§ 28-4007 and 28-4135.
- D.** Before a binder submitted as proof of financial responsibility expires, a motor carrier shall submit:
1. A binder from an insurance company other than the insurance company named in the first binder; or
 2. Proof of financial responsibility listed in subsections (C)(1) or (C)(3) through (C)(5).

- A.** ~~All insurance filings made on behalf of motor carriers pursuant to this rule shall be completed observing the following procedures for filing and canceling insurance policies.~~
- B.** ~~In lieu of providing to the Motor Vehicle Division the original or certified copy of the insurance policy, the Form E, Uniform Motor Carrier Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability Certificate of Insurance may be filed. The certificate must contain the following information:~~
- ~~1. The Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, shall be named as the Commission.~~
 - ~~2. The full name and address of the insurance carrier.~~
 - ~~3. The full name and address of the insured.~~
 - ~~4. Effective date of the insurance policy.~~
 - ~~5. Insurance policy number.~~
 - ~~6. Signature of authorized representative.~~
- C.** ~~Notice of Cancellation. The Form K, Uniform Notice of Cancellation of Motor Carrier Insurance Policy, shall be used in all cases when an insurance policy is canceled. The Form K must contain the following information:~~
- ~~1. The Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, shall appear as the Commission.~~
 - ~~2. The full name and address of the insured.~~
 - ~~3. The full name and address of the insurance carrier.~~
 - ~~4. Cancellation effective date.~~
 - ~~5. Signature of authorized representative.~~

R17-5-506. ~~Certificate of Insurance; Procedures for Preparing, Filing and Canceling Liability Insurance Failure to Maintain Proof of Financial Responsibility and Suspension~~

- A.** ~~A Certificate of Insurance may be submitted in lieu of the Form E required under R17-5-505 on behalf of motor carrier vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of R17-5-504. The Certificate of Insurance shall contain the following information:~~
- ~~1. The full name, address and telephone number of the producer.~~
 - ~~2. The full name, address and telephone number of the insured.~~
 - ~~3. The full name, address and telephone number of the insurance carrier.~~
 - ~~4. The liability insurance policy number.~~
 - ~~5. Policy effective date.~~
 - ~~6. Policy expiration date.~~
 - ~~7. The amount of liability coverage.~~
 - ~~8. If multiple liability insurance policies have been written, such as layered or excess coverage, all names, addresses, telephone numbers, policy numbers, effective dates and expiration dates as indicated in this rule shall be provided and itemized on the Certificate of Insurance.~~
 - ~~9. The Arizona Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, shall be named as the Certificate Holder.~~
- B.** ~~Notice of Cancellation. All Certificate of Insurance filings shall contain a cancellation statement similar to the following: "Should any of the above described policies be canceled before the expiration date thereof, the issuing company will mail a 45-day notice to the Certificate Holder. Failure to mail such notice shall impose obligation or liability upon the insurance carrier." Such notice of cancellation shall run from the date notice was mailed from the insurance carrier.~~
- A.** If a motor carrier's proof of financial responsibility expires, is cancelled, or lapses, with no new proof of financial responsibility submitted to the Division, the Division shall send the motor carrier a dated intent-to-suspend notice by regular mail.
1. A motor carrier shall, within 20 days after the date of the intent-to-suspend notice, submit to the Division proof of financial responsibility that complies with R17-5-504.

2. If a motor carrier does not submit proof of financial responsibility within the time prescribed under subsection (A)(1), the Division shall immediately suspend the motor carrier's vehicle registration.
3. If a motor carrier submits proof of financial responsibility during a suspension, the Division shall immediately reinstate the motor carrier's vehicle registration.

B. A motor carrier may request a hearing for a vehicle registration suspension as follows:

1. 17 A.A.C. 1, Article 5 applies to a hearing request and to any hearing.
2. An Administrative Law Judge shall limit the scope of a hearing to whether the motor carrier has proof of financial responsibility under R17-5-505.

R17-5-507. Certification when Form E Not Required Repealed

- A.** ~~Any owner, lessor, or lessee of a motor vehicle with a declared gross weight of 26,000 pounds or less, who is subject to the financial responsibility requirements prescribed in R17-5-504, and who registers the motor vehicle, shall file an original of a certificate of insurance with the Motor Vehicle Division Insurance Unit. The certificate of insurance shall be issued by an insurance carrier, and contain the following information:~~
1. ~~The full name, address, and telephone number of the producer;~~
 2. ~~The full name, address, and telephone number of the insured;~~
 3. ~~The full name, address, and telephone number of the insurance carrier;~~
 4. ~~The policy number;~~
 5. ~~The policy effective date;~~
 6. ~~The policy expiration date;~~
 7. ~~The amounts and types of coverage provided; and~~
 8. ~~If multiple liability insurance policies have been written, name, address, telephone number, policy number, effective date, and expiration date of each liability insurance policy.~~
- B.** ~~The Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division, shall be named as the certificate holder.~~
- C.** ~~The owner, lessor, or lessee of a motor vehicle who is required to file a certificate of insurance under this Section may list a self-insured retention on the certificate of insurance only if a certificate of self-insurance issued by the state pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 28-1222 or 28-1235 is filed with the certificate of insurance.~~
- D.** ~~A copy of the certificate of insurance shall be submitted with the registration application at the time of initial registration or renewal for each motor vehicle.~~
- E.** ~~All certificates of insurance shall contain a cancellation statement similar to the following: "Should any of the above described policies be canceled before the expiration date thereof, the issuing company shall mail a 45-day notice to the certificate holder. Failure to mail such notice shall impose obligation or liability upon the insurance carrier." The notice of cancellation shall be effective from the date the notice is mailed by the insurance carrier.~~
- F.** ~~Upon receipt of a notice of cancellation, or upon expiration of an insurance policy that the owner, lessor, or lessee of a motor vehicle, the Motor Vehicle Division shall suspend the registration of the motor vehicle. The registration suspension shall remain in effect until a valid certificate of insurance covering the motor vehicle is filed with the Motor Vehicle Division.~~
- G.** ~~The Motor Vehicle Division may randomly verify compliance with the Motor Carrier Financial Responsibility Act. If it is not possible to verify compliance by the owner, lessor, or lessee of a motor vehicle, the Motor Vehicle Division shall mail a notice of intent to suspend the registration of the motor vehicle to the owner, lessor, or lessee. The notice shall indicate that registration of the motor vehicle shall be suspended unless a valid certificate of insurance is filed with the Motor Vehicle Division within 30 days from the date on which the notice is mailed to the owner, lessor, or lessee. A suspended registration shall remain suspended until a valid certificate of insurance is filed with the Motor Vehicle Division.~~

6. An explanation of the rules, including the agency's reasons for initiating the rules:

A.R.S. § 41-1073 requires all state agencies to adopt licensing time-frames during which the agency will either grant or deny each type of license it issues. "License" is defined in A.R.S. § 49-1001(10) as including the whole or part of any agency permit, certificate, approval, registration, charter or similar form of permission required by law, but it does not include a license required solely for revenue purposes.

This rulemaking updates the licensing time-frames for rules that were repealed or amended in January 2001 and no longer apply to the current Aquifer Protection Permit (APP) or Reclaimed Water programs, including repealing the time-frames for wastewater approval-to-construct (ATC) and approvals of construction (AOC) licenses, which no longer exist. The rules add time-frames for temporary individual permits and time-frames for Type 3 General Permits, and Type 4 General Permits previously covered under the ATC and AOC process.

The wastewater time extension approval listed in "other wastewater licenses" under Group III, in Tables 6, 6E, 6N, and 6S pertains to the sewerage rules repealed January 1, 2001 and no longer exists. The CWA § 208 consistency review is an application component and must be completed by the applicant before the Department determines the application to be complete.

The six standard and complex subdivision sanitary facility approvals currently listed in Tables 7, 7-N, and 7-S have been condensed to two approvals under the "subdivision approvals" category in the new Table 10. The new approach assumes that the more complex evaluation occurs for on-site systems and that community facilities connected using sewer lines is a standard (and shorter) review.

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VEMUR approvals, currently listed in Tables 10 and 12, no longer exist.

The time-frames for transfer approvals, closure plan approvals, and post closure plan approvals currently listed in Table 10 are not separate approvals/licenses, but are handled as permit amendments.

The drywell registration and significant industrial user registration time-frames currently listed in Table 10, Group IX, are completed within seven-days after receipt of application and therefore are not subject to time-frames under A.R.S. § 41-1078(A).

The time-frames for “pesticide contamination prevention licenses,” currently in Table 10, Group X, have been transferred to new Table 7.

“Noneffluent groundwater recharge licenses” are issued by the state Department of Water Resources (DWR). The Department’s involvement with this license is a consulting issue, rather than a license approval. The Department offers technical review and input to DWR, and DWR makes the licensing decision for groundwater recharge permits based upon our information and many other judgements made by their staff. The ultimate decision to issue rests with DWR. DWR has licensing time-frames established in regulations for their decision process. The time-frames and administrative processes in the Department’s current LTF rule conflict with DWR time-frames and processes. This conflict causes confusion for the applicants, for DWR staff, and for Department staff administering the program. For these reasons time-frames for these licenses, currently in Table 10, Group VIII, have been deleted.

The rulemaking amends Table 12 to coincide with the January 2001 Section numbering changes of the Aquifer Protection Permitting program and transfers the biosolid applicator registration request acknowledgment from Table 12 to Table 10, now authorized under A.R.S. § 49-255.03.

The rulemaking includes new licensing time-frames for individual permits and pretreatment approvals under the Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) permitting program, which became effective December 7, 2001 and for which the Department received EPA approval to administer the program on December 5, 2002.

The Department believes that the new Table 10 format provides stakeholders with an easier and clearer understanding of the number of days designated for the administrative and substantive review portions of the licensing time-frames. Many of the current licensing categories, such as the duplication of licenses under the various tables have never been implemented by the Department because the program is not set up to designate a separate (but same) type of license for different types of facilities, or from a different Department location. The new format segregates the name of the permit, the statutory and rule authorities, and includes the total number of days in the overall time-frame. Stakeholders can quickly determine what steps are taken by the Water Permits Section when administering licensing-time-frames and clears up any confusion that currently exists. The new table also provides a two-part substantive review process, which is an important condition in the Aquifer Protection Permitting program. Once an application is reviewed and the administrative review process complete, a Type 4 General Permit stakeholder may take up to two years to build a facility. The permitting process is suspended until the applicant notifies the Department that the facility is complete and the applicant provides documentation regarding the construction. After the Department reviews these documents for completeness, the second segment of the substantive review process commences to allow the Department to verify that the facility meets the conditions previously specified by the Department.

The Type 4 General Permits listed in Table 10 are those with time-frames for a single on-site wastewater treatment system that can operate individually, such as the systems established under the 4.01, 4.02, 4.03, 4.13, 4.14, and 4.23 General Permits.

Licenses that must be issued in combination with one or more general permits to complete an on-site system are addressed at the end of the Type 4 General Permit time-frames, and include the 4.04 through 4.12 and 4.15 through 4.22 General Permits. These “combined permits” address when a primary permit must include another general permit. For example, a 4.04 pressure distribution system general permit must be combined with other permits to complete the treatment system. A 4.02 system can be approved as a stand-alone system or combined with other general permits to complete a treatment system.

Time-frames for pesticide contamination prevention licenses (new Table 7) and time-frames for solid waste licenses (Table 12) have not changed in this rulemaking. The only changes made to these Tables consist of updating citations and moving the pesticide contamination prevention licenses from Table 10, Group X, to new Table 7.

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9. The summary of the economic, small business, and consumer impact:

It is not anticipated that the adoption of this rule will have any impact on private industry, small business, or consumers. This rule action provides the codification of the time-frames currently observed by the Water Permits Section of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.

Although the time-frames proposed in Table 10 appear to have changed from the repealed rules, the proposed time-frames actually address entirely new permits promulgated in the January 2001 rulemaking. The January 2001 rulemaking combined several programs and streamlined the permitting process. In the Aquifer Protection Permitting program, permits included not only individual permits, which are issued on a case-by-case basis, but general permits, which were organized into four separate categories (Type 1, Type 2, Type 3, and Type 4), depending upon the requirements for each type.

Time-frames for pesticide contamination prevention licenses (new Table 7) and solid waste licenses (Table 12) have not changed in this rulemaking.

The rule provides stakeholders with all time-frames categories used to administer a permit, including the time considered if a public hearing is held.

A. Estimated Costs and Benefits to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.

Except for the time-frames for the AZPDES permitting program, which has not yet been approved by EPA, or implemented by the Department, this rulemaking codifies the time-frames and procedures already observed by the Water Permits Section in administering the programs regulated by this time-frame rule.

The following table describes the licenses issued by the Department in the last five calendar years and does not include the licenses/permits issued by delegated agencies.

C. Businesses Directly Affected By the Rulemaking.

Any businesses applying for a license will follow current procedures and practices and no additional costs or benefits will occur. The rule will provide an intangible benefit for these businesses by identifying the time-frames within which the Department (Water Permits Section, Northern and Southern Regional Offices, Hydrologic Support and Assessment Section, or Compliance Section) will approve or deny licenses.

D. Estimated Costs and Benefits to Private and Public Employment.

Private and public employment are not directly affected by the implementation of this rulemaking.

E. Estimated Costs and Benefits to Consumers and the Public.

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If consumers and the public follow current procedures and practices when applying for licenses, no additional costs or benefits will occur. Consumers may also receive an intangible benefit by the identification of specific time limits for processing licenses.

F. *Estimated Costs and Benefits to State Revenues.*

This rulemaking will have no impact on state revenues unless the Department does not grant or deny a license within the established time-frames and is required to refund fees and pay a penalty.

Requirements of A.R.S. § 41-1035.

This rulemaking establishes time-frames within which the Department must act and does not impose compliance and reporting requirements upon the regulated public.

10. A description of the changes between the proposed rules, including supplemental notices, and final rules (if applicable):

The time-frames in Table 10 for the 4.02, 4.03, 4.13, and 4.14 General Permits are identical and all deal with time-frames for one Type 4 General Permit. These categories have been combined into one overall category called "Standard Single."

The Administrative Code authorities were corrected in Table 10 for "Standard Combined" and "Complex Combined," and footnote 2 was corrected from subsection R18-9-A312(H) to subsection R18-9-A312(G). The total substantive review time-frame for "complex combined" was incorrectly stated in the proposed rulemaking and has been corrected from 64 days to 94 days.

Grammatical and clarification rule changes were made at the request of Council staff.

11. A summary of the comments made regarding the rules and the agency response to them:

Comment: A commenter expressed concern with the lengthy periods of time to review and issue aquifer protection permits ("APPs") or amendments to the permits (*i.e.*, 221 to 266 business days for individual permits, 284 to 329 business days for complex individual permits, and 221 to 266 business days for significant permit amendments). The commenter understands that the Department may shorten these time periods based on its willingness to push permits or amendments on a faster track, but the commenter believes that the Department has been unwilling in many instances to move critical permits or amendments on a faster track to accommodate important business interests. The commenter believes that the Department should reevaluate and shorten the time-frames to be more reasonable and allow for business expansion and development. The commenter believes that the existing time-frames work as a substantial deterrent against new businesses choosing to locate or expand in Arizona.

Response: The time-frames for individual permits and significant amendments have not been changed from the existing rule. The Department strives to issue permit actions in a timely fashion and, depending on the responsiveness of the applicant and the complexity of the permitting action, can issue an individual permit in six to nine months from the application submittal. However, if there are disagreements over BADCT or the applicant changes the application during the process, the issuance is delayed. To date, the Department has not exceeded time-frames for individual APPs or significant amendments. With increased staff vacancies due to the state budget shortfall, the Department believes it must strike a balance between time-frames and limited staff resources to allow adequate time to process the applications.

The Department would like to accommodate requests to expedite a particular application and does so as time allows. In fact, we have adjusted our schedules to do just that. However, at any one time, there are over 200 major permit actions in process and staff cannot accommodate every request without delaying another permit action whose applicant may feel their interests are as important as the applicant asking for special treatment. No change has been made to the rule.

Comment: The commenter questions the proposed time-frame (180 business days) for issuance of a temporary individual permit. The APP rules (A.A.C. R18-8-A210) limit the types of discharges that can qualify for temporary individual permits to certain pilot projects and temporary discharges that last no more than six months. These types of potential discharging activities do not warrant a time-frame of 180 business days in which to complete the permit review and issuance process. The commenter believes that the Department should shorten the proposed time-frame by at least 100 business days. This would still give the Department up to four months in which to review and issue temporary individual permits.

Response: Although the temporary individual permit is issued for a limited time period, the temporary permit is as complex as any individual permit. The Department must allow adequate time to process the applications as it balances its resources and workload. No change has been made to the rule.

Comment: A commenter questions the proposed time-frames for review and issuance of AZPDES permits. The commenter believes that the proposed time-frames are inconsistent with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") NPDES regulations as well as with the rules adopted by ADEQ to implement the AZPDES permit program. For example, the AZPDES rules provide that a person shall apply for an AZPDES individual permit at least 180 days before the date of the discharge or a later date if granted by the Director. (A.A.C. R18-9-B901(A)(1)) The AZPDES rules also provide that a person who proposes a construction activity and wishes coverage under an individual permit shall apply for an AZPDES individual permit at least 90 days before the date on which construction is to commence. (A.A.C. R18-9-B901(A)(2)) The AZPDES rules further provide that an existing AZPDES permit holder should reapply for an individual permit 180 days before the permit expiration date. (A.A.C. R18-9-B904(B)(1)) Notwithstanding

these regulatory provisions, the Department's proposed time-frames for review and issuance of AZPDES permits provide for potential time periods of well beyond 180 days for such reviews. The commenter questions the legality of ADEQ's proposed time-frames in light of the time periods established in the Department's AZPDES permit regulations (similar time-frames are established in EPA's NPDES regulations). The commenter believes that the time-frames should be shortened to provide for completion of administrative completeness and substantive review within the 90 or 180 day submittal periods established under the AZPDES rules and EPA's NPDES regulations.

Response: 40 CFR 122.21(c) and (d) require an applicant for a new NPDES permit or renewal of an existing permit to submit an application at least 180 days before the proposed discharge date or the expiration date, respectively. However, there is no requirement in the federal regulations mandating that these applications be processed by the permitting authority in that, or in any specified, time-frame. In fact, processing NPDES permits by EPA has historically taken much longer than 180 days. As a result, although a new applicant may have submitted an application 180 days before planned discharge, there was a good probability the permit was not received at the anticipated time. As an applicant may not discharge until a permit is in hand, the federal time-frames in regulation can be misleading.

The time-frames for an AZPDES individual permit are the same as those for individual Aquifer Protection Permits because an equivalent amount of work is required to process both types of applications. The Department intends to make every effort to accelerate the issuance of AZPDES permits and expects them to generally be completed in advance of the proposed time-frames. However, the Department considers that, based on the type of circumstances that can delay permits, the proposed time-frames will allow resolution of most issues with applicants.

Based on comments received during an informal comment period on the draft rule, the Department adjusted the time-frames for an individual construction stormwater AZPDES permit. The time-frame is longer than the 90 days application schedule in rule as the commenter has stated, but there is no correlation between the 90-day submittal requirement and the length of time the Department has to issue or deny a permit. 40 CFR 122.21(c) cautions persons proposing a new discharge to submit their applications well in advance of the 90 or 180 day requirements to avoid delay.

40 CFR 124.3(a)(2) establishes that the state Director shall not begin the processing of a permit until the applicant has fully complied with the application requirements for that permit. Once the application is complete, the Department must determine whether it will issue or deny a permit. 40 CFR 124.3 establishes that the regional administration shall review permit applications for completeness within 30 to 60 days, depending upon the type of application. If the Department is strictly held to the 180 day limit (administrative and substantive) to take a final permit action, there will be less time for negotiation and issue resolution, which could lead to increased denial of permits.

The Department is currently working on an AZPDES stormwater general permit for construction activities and the Department believes that the majority of construction activities will choose this option. Facilities who submit a notice of intent to discharge under the general permit will be screened to determine if they meet the general permit requirements. Only those who cannot qualify to discharge under the general permit will be required to apply for an individual AZPDES permit. It is anticipated that the construction activities requiring individual permitting will have complications that will demand adequate time-frames for the Department to address those issues in the permitting process.

- 5 "Major facility" means any NPDES "facility or activity" classified as such by the EPA in conjunction with the Director.
- 6 "Minor facility" means any facility that is not classified as a major facility.
