The Securities Division proposes amending rule 116 to reflect the revised name and to incorporate the amended Statement of Policy. The NASAA Statement of Policy Regarding Church Extension Fund Securities is the standard of review for the registration of debt securities issued by a church extension fund, the proceeds of which primarily finance or refinance the purchase, construction, or improvement of church property and/or buildings or related capital expenditures or the operational needs of various affiliated churches and related religious organizations of a denomination.
