Substantive policy statement #SP-062-PHS-EMS notified the public that the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) was modifying the admission requirements for the Arizona EMT-B refresher and the Arizona ALS refresher, pending completion of rulemaking to modify the language pertaining to the admission requirements in A.A.C. R9-25-306(B)(2)(a)(iii) and R9-25-309(B)(2)(a)(iii). The final rulemaking amending A.A.C. R9-25-306(B)(2)(a)(iii) and R9-25-309(B)(2)(a)(iii) was published on January 28, 2005, at 11 A.A.R. 553, and became effective March 5, 2005. Thus, ADHS is rescinding substantive policy statement #SP-062-PHS-EMS, effective March 5, 2005.
