Pursuant to 18 A.A.C. 5, Article 5, Minimum Design Criteria, the Department prescribes minimum design standards for public water systems, and reviews plans and specifications for the systems. The purpose of this rulemaking is establish, by administrative rule, fees for performing technical reviews of plans for public water systems. The Department has a statutory responsibility to review plans for these facilities, and to assess fees for its reviews. A.R.S. § 49-353(A).
