

## NOTICES OF SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS

This substantive policy statement informs the general public of ADEQ's current approach to, or opinion of, the air quality modeling procedures that may be used as part of the air quality permit applications process. This applies to sources located in Arizona whenever they are deemed appropriate for use on a case by case basis as determined by ADEQ. This document replaces the previous edition of ADEQ's *Modeling Guidelines* dated June 22, 1998, and represents the current in-use procedures.

This guidance provides assistance to applicants required to perform modeling analyses to demonstrate that the air quality impacts from new and existing sources protect public health, general welfare, physical property, and the natural environment. This guidance clarifies issues described in EPA documents, facilitates the applicant in developing an acceptable modeling analysis, and assists ADEQ in expediting the permit review process. The guidelines also outline additional air quality modeling requirements specific to ADEQ.
