#### 1. Subject Matter of the Proposed Rule

The proposed revisions to local air quality rules involve the following:

1. Update amended dates for Chapter 1, article 3 in §1-1-105
2. Update amended dates for Chapter 4, article 2 in §1-1-105
3. Update amended date for §7-1-030 listed in §1-1-107
4. Addition of T-Butyl Acetate (TBAC) to the list of nonprecursor organic compounds (§1-3-140.89) which reflect EPA's revisions to the definition of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC).
5. Update wording in §1-3-140.79, Major Source (Major Stationary Source) regarding updates to list of Hazardous Air Pollutants Section 112(b) of the Clean Air Act.
6. Updates to Chapter 6, Article 1, section 030 New Source Performance Standards
7. Updates to Chapter 7, Article 1, section 030 Performance Standards for Federally listed hazardous air pollutants.

Upon adoption by the Board of Supervisors, the revised rules (including previous rule revisions completed in 2005) will be presented to the Governor of Arizona for transmittal to the Administrator of the EPA with a request that it be included as an element in the Arizona SIP.

#### 2. Prior Related Notices

The EPA formally revised the Definition of Volatile Organic Compounds which excludes T-Butyl Acetate (TBAC). See 69 Fed. Reg. 69298 (11/29/04) at <http://www.gpoaccess.gov/fr/index.html>.

At a later date, the District will publish a Notice of Proposed Rule Making that will define a formal timetable for submittal of oral or written comments. At any time prior to the close of that to-be-defined comment period, anyone may seek information or submit comments by contacting the Planning Manager at the address shown above. Ultimately, the public will also have an opportunity to offer comment in the public hearing before the Board of Supervisors.

**5. Anticipated Timetable**

The District anticipates that the rulemaking record will close on or about May 17, 2006, and that final adoption, in a public hearing before the Board of Supervisors, will be held on or about June 28, 2006.
