The Arizona Game and Fish Commission is amending R12-4-802 to close portions of the Chevelon Creek Wildlife Area, located in game management unit 4B, to prevent vandalism of both a Native American ruin and a site reserved for construction of a pumping station. The rulemaking will allow for yearlong closure of approximately eight acres, which encompasses both locations. Closures will not affect the rest of the wildlife area.

- 6. An explanation of the rule, including the agency's reasons for initiating the rule, including the statutory citation to the exemption from regular rulemaking procedures:**  
Fees or charges established by the Arizona State Parks Board in accordance with A.R.S. § 41-511.05 are exempt from Council and Attorney General review by A.R.S. § 41-1005(A)(19). Exhibit A, Fees and Permits set the fees for visitor use and commercial use at Arizona State Parks. Each year, the Arizona State Parks Board reviews its fee structure and approves adjustments for the ensuing calendar year. In its analysis, Arizona State Parks reviews fee structures of surrounding states; reviews operating and development costs of the State Park System; reviews the public demand for

park services and subsequent impacts of visitor use on park resources. State Parks actively pursues public input into the fee structure through regional meetings throughout the State.

Since March 1, 2006, Arizona State Parks has taken additional public comment, and held staff reviews of the agency's Annual Pass program. Administrative and usage descriptions for the current pass program have been developed. These changes are less restrictive, and there is no change to the actual fee for either pass. Additional discussions with the Arizona State Parks Board Chairman have been held and approval to implement these changes has been obtained.
