

## NOTICES OF SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS

The Administrative Procedure Act requires the publication of substantive policy statements issued by agencies (A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(14)). Substantive policy statements are written expressions which inform the general public of an agency's current approach to rule or regulation practice. Substantive policy statements are advisory only. A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that a substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties you may petition the agency under A.R.S. § 41-1033 for a review of the statement.

The Arizona Division of Occupational Safety and Health has adopted federal OSHA's CPL 02-00-141, instruction guidelines for inspection scheduling for construction. ADOSH has written a new policy and procedure, # 2006-02, Programmed Construction Inspection Targeting, that encompasses the federal inspection guidelines and inspection scheduling for construction as identified in OSHA's CPL 02-00-141.

**2. Date the substantive policy statement was issued and the effective date of the policy statement if different from the issuance date:**

September 21, 2006

**3. Summary of the contents of the substantive policy statement:**

This instruction and guidelines explains OSHA's major site - specific targeting program for the construction industry and provides ADOSH with the direction and means to schedule randomly selected safety compliance inspections of

construction sites within the state of Arizona. Due to the mobility of the construction industry, the transitory nature of construction work sites, and the fact that construction work sites frequently involve more than one construction employer, inspections are scheduled from a list of construction work sites rather than construction employers. OSHA will provide to the ADOSH Director a randomly selected list of construction projects from all identified or known covered active projects. This list will contain the project number of the sites the ADOSH Division plans on inspecting during the next month.

The identical instructions and guidelines found in the OSHA CPL 02-00-141, have been incorporated into ADOSH's new policy and procedure # 2006-02.
