

**EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS OF
GENERAL APPLICABILITY, AND STATEMENTS
ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR
PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)**

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed. With the exception of egregious errors, content (including spelling, grammar, and punctuation) of these orders has been reproduced as submitted.

*** WOMEN AND GIRLS HIV/AIDS AWARENESS DAY ***

WHEREAS, human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS) remain a leading cause of illness and death in the United States; and

WHEREAS, at the end of 2003, an estimated one quarter of the approximately one million people estimated to be living with HIV in the U.S. were unaware of their infection and therefore unable to benefit from clinical care to reduce morbidity and mortality; and

WHEREAS, in Arizona, the number of women and girls living with HIV/AIDS has more than doubled in the last decade from 5.5% to 13.6% of the total number of people living with HIV/AIDS; and

WHEREAS, treatment has improved survival rates dramatically, however, progress in effecting earlier diagnosis has been insufficient;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Janet Napolitano, Governor of Arizona do hereby encourage the empowerment of women through education and proclaim March 10, 2007 as
