EXECUTIVE ORDER 2007-28
Continuing the Arizona Statewide Youth Development Task Force
(Amending and Superseding Executive Order 2004-14)

[M07-689]

WHEREAS, youth development strategies can help youth become healthy and productive adults by developing attitudes, behaviors, and skills that enable them to succeed as parents, citizens, and workers; and

WHEREAS, research shows that youth who spend time in communities that are rich in developmental opportunities engage in less risky behaviors and show evidence of higher rates of positive development as they enter adulthood; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Statewide Youth Development Task Force was formed in 2004 and has made recommendations for the benefit of over one million school age youth in the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, these recommendations are set forth in a comprehensive framework for youth development entitled, *The Five Keys for Youth Success: Unlocking the Door to Arizona's Future*;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Napolitano, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, hereby order and direct as follows:

1. The Arizona Statewide Youth Development Task Force (the "Task Force") is hereby continued and ordered to help the State to implement the recommendations outlined in the *Five Keys to Youth Success: Unlocking the Door to Arizona's Future*.
2. The Task Force shall continue to be comprised of not more than 25 members representing not only diverse expertise in the youth development field but a cross-section of Arizonans of various ethnicities, geographic locations, and ages. Each member shall be appointed by the Governor and serve, without compensation, at the pleasure of the Governor. Youth ages 10-24 shall comprise at least one-third of the total membership throughout the structure of the Task Force and each of its Implementation Work Groups.
3. Members of the Arizona Statewide Youth Development Task Force may, with the Governor's permission, send designees to serve on the Task Force; provided, however, that such designees shall have been delegated by the member with full authority to vote and otherwise act on behalf of the member.
4. The Governor shall appoint a chair of the Task Force who shall have the ability to convene the Task Force. In the chair's absence, a vice chair, as appointed by the Governor, shall serve as chair. The Task Force shall meet at the call of the chair, no more than six times per year.
5. The Task Force shall advise the Governor on youth development policy and implementation of its recommendations through the following activities:
 - The creation of Implementation Groups on matters relating to the *5 Keys to Youth Success*:
 - Caring Adults
 - Youth Engagement
 - Activities Outside of School
 - High School Completion
 - Work Readiness Skills

- The promotion of youth development strategies within state agencies, non-profits, and philanthropies.
 - The coordination of services for Arizona's youth with community-based, faith-based, city, state and local youth-serving agencies and organizations.
 - The ongoing review of proposed federal and state legislation and existing laws relating to youth and youth development.
6. The Task Force shall be staffed and supported by the Governor's Division for Community and Youth Development within the Governor's Office for Children, Youth and Families.
 7. The Task Force shall sunset on December 31, 2010 unless otherwise continued by Executive Order.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 2007-29
To Spend Money from the Health Crisis Fund on
Syphilis Prevention and Education Campaign

[M07-687]

WHEREAS, syphilis outbreaks have increased in communities throughout Arizona, including a 25-fold increase in syphilis cases in Maricopa County over the last six months compared to the same period in 2000; and

WHEREAS, persons with undiagnosed syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases may experience impaired health, tissue damage, serious disability, and death; and

WHEREAS, pregnant women with undiagnosed syphilis may experience stillbirth or birth of an infant with congenital abnormalities such as meningitis, brain damage, skeletal abnormalities, heart defects, and other organ abnormalities; and

WHEREAS, identification of syphilis through surveillance and rapid response through intervention can mitigate the spread of disease; and

WHEREAS, education of healthcare providers regarding the need for syphilis and other sexually transmitted disease testing and further appropriate intervention activities will improve treatment and reduce transmission; and

WHEREAS, education of the public regarding the nature of sexually transmitted diseases, risks for infection, and the need for testing will increase the detection rates of sexually transmitted diseases; and

WHEREAS, conducting rapid disease investigation and case management activities, including contact tracing, will prevent progression of disease in Arizona; and

WHEREAS, these circumstance are neither a contingency nor an emergency pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-192 because they require neither state-municipal resource coordination nor Department of Emergency and Military Affairs assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Napolitano, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Arizona Constitution and the laws of the State, declare a significant potential for a health crisis in the State, and hereby order as follows:

1. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 36-797, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be transferred from the Health Crisis Fund to the Department of Health Services to bring current syphilis outbreaks under control and reduce the likelihood of outbreak recurrence in the State.
2. The Department of Health Services shall expend all moneys transferred pursuant to this Order on measures to educate providers and the public about the risks of syphilis and increase the number of Arizonans that are tested for syphilis and other sexually transmitted diseases and control current syphilis outbreaks and shall report to the Legislature and the Governor by June 30, 2008 on the expenditure of all sums so transferred.

WHEREAS, Native American people have lived in what is now Arizona since time immemorial and today, 22 federally recognized Tribes, Nations, Communities and Pueblo call Arizona home; and

WHEREAS, although today we recognize that the members of these tribes are citizens of their respective tribal nations, citi-

zens of Arizona, and citizens of the United States of America, such was not always the case; and

WHEREAS, despite the fact that before World War I, Native Americans who lived on reservations in Arizona were not considered citizens of the United States and were thus exempt from the draft, more than 8,000 Native Americans served in the United States armed forces during World War I, some giving their lives in the defense of their homes and our freedom; and

WHEREAS, in response to these valuable contributions, and with the advocacy of Native American leaders such as Dr. Carlos Montezuma, a Yavapai man, the United States Congress passed the Indian Citizenship Act in 1924, which guaranteed certain citizenship rights to Native Americans, but did not guarantee the right to vote in Arizona elections; and

WHEREAS, Peter Porter, a member of the Gila River Indian Community, brought suit seeking to secure voting rights for Native Americans in Arizona, but was rebuffed by the Arizona Supreme Court; and

WHEREAS, during World War II, Congress passed the Nationality Act of 1940, reaffirming the citizenship of Native Americans, and inspiring more than 25,000 Native Americans to serve in the military, with some, like Ira Hayes of the Gila River Indian Community, becoming national heroes; and

WHEREAS, when these soldiers returned home and were once again denied many of the freedoms they fought to preserve, two Yavapai men, Frank Harrison and Harry Austin, with the help of Arizona Congressman Richard Harless and Lemuel and Ben Mathews, won a landmark Arizona Supreme Court case confirming the rights of Native Americans to vote because “in a democracy, suffrage is the most basic civil right” and the denial of that right “does violence to the principles of freedom and equality;” and

WHEREAS, although Arizona law now recognizes the right of Native American citizens of Arizona to vote in State elections, it remains vital that we work together to ensure that every eligible voter is able to exercise this most fundamental right;
