PURSUANT TO A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(3)

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires the full-text publication of all Executive Orders and Proclamations of General Applicability issued by the Governor. In addition, the *Register* shall include each statement filed by the Governor in granting a commutation, pardon or reprieve, or stay or suspension of execution where a sentence of death is imposed. With the exception of egregious errors, content (including spelling, grammar, and punctuation) of these orders has been reproduced as submitted.

WHEREAS, Ernest W. McFarland "Mac" contributed to Arizona history by serving his state in the three highest branches of government; as Governor, United States Senator and Supreme Court Justice; and

WHEREAS, McFarland State Historic Park, formerly the Pinal County Courthouse, is the oldest standing courthouse in the State of Arizona. Constructed primarily of adobe, it contained the courtroom, sheriff's office, the judge's chambers and the county jail; and

WHEREAS, "Mac" McFarland is commonly referred to as the "Father of the G.I. Bill" because he was a co-sponsor in 1944; and

WHEREAS, "Mac" McFarland's major contributions as Governor include the groundwork on the Central Arizona Project and signing the bill that founded the Arizona State Parks system in 1957; and

WHEREAS, in 1968, the Pinal County Historical Society acquired and maintained the building as a museum; and

WHEREAS, today the building houses exhibits depicting the history of the area, including the Ernest McFarland Archives and a World War II POW camp; and

WHEREAS, McFarland State Historic Park will celebrate Veteran's Day by representing time periods from 1775 to the present. McFarland State Historic Park will also celebrate the 50th birthday of Arizona State Parks;
