*** CAMPUS FIRE SAFETY MONTH ***

WHEREAS, since January 2000, at least 125 people, including students, parents and children have lost their lives in student housing fires with over 80 percent of these deaths having occurred in off-campus occupancies and a majority of students across the nation live off-campus; and

WHEREAS, automatic fire alarm systems provide the necessary early warning to occupants and the fire department of a fire so that appropriate action can be taken; and

WHEREAS, automatic fire sprinkler systems are a highly effective method of controlling or extinguishing a fire in its early stages, protecting the lives of the building's occupants; and

WHEREAS, many students are living in off-campus occupancies, Greek housing, and residence halls that are not adequately protected with automatic fire sprinkler systems and automatic fire alarm systems; and

WHEREAS, fire safety education is an effective method of reducing the occurrence of fires and reducing the resulting loss of life and property; and

WHEREAS, it is vital to educate Arizona about the importance of fire safety to ensure students' wellbeing for the college years and beyond.
