The Maricopa County Air Quality Department (department) regulates emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) from the graphic arts industry through the Maricopa County Air Pollution Control Regulation III, Rule 337: Graphic Arts. The rule is being amended to reflect Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) recommendations from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) contained in the Control Techniques Guidance (CTG) documents. The department is proposing amendments to the current rule that would: revise and add definitions of key terms used in the rule; implement certain emission control requirements; modify recordkeeping requirements; and include a limited exemption for digital printing operations. As part of this rulemaking, the department may add, delete, or modify additional rules as necessary.
