Under Laws 2008, Ch. 288, § 2, the legislature required, beginning January 1, 2011, a person who practices as a behavior analyst in Arizona must be licensed under A.R.S. Title 32, Chapter 19.1, Article 4. The Board has been licensing behavior analysts since January 1, 2011, under a waiver provided by Laws 2010, Ch. 299, § 2, if the behavior analyst meets certain specified conditions. The waiver ends August 15, 2012. This rulemaking, which is made under an exception to the Governor's rulemaking moratorium, granted by Steven Killian, Assistant Policy Advisor, dated June 22, 2011, will complement the newly enacted statute.

The Board is also updating and adding materials incorporated by reference regarding factory-built buildings, subassemblies, and components to comply with statute, which requires the Office to impose minimum construction requirements that are reasonably consistent with nationally recognized and accepted practices (see A.R.S. § 41-2144(A)(1)).
