The change in the rule is to comply with Title XI of the Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery, and Enforcement Act of 1989, which requires state licensing boards to recognize and enforce the *Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice* (USPAP); and A.R.S. § 32-3605(B)(1), which requires the Board to adopt standards for professional appraisal practice that are at least equal to USPAP.
