

NOTICES OF SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENTS

The Administrative Procedure Act requires the publication of substantive policy statements issued by agencies (A.R.S. § 41-1013(B)(14)). Substantive policy statements are written expressions which inform the general public of an agency's current approach to rule or regulation practice. Substantive policy statements are advisory only. A substantive policy statement does not include internal procedural documents that only affect the internal procedures of the agency and does not impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties or include confidential information or rules made in accordance with the Arizona Administrative Procedure Act. If you believe that a substantive policy statement does impose additional requirements or penalties on regulated parties you may petition the agency under A.R.S. § 41-1033 for a review of the statement.

This bulletin announces the adjustment to the threshold amount of property damages insurers may use to nonrenew private passenger automobile policies under A.R.S. § 20-1631(E). The property damage threshold level is increased to \$2,570.

This bulletin announces the filing fee for non-profit military mutual aid associations. The Legislature amended A.R.S. § 20-861 by defining “association or order” and adding non-profit military mutual aid associations to types of fraternal benefit societies. The Legislature also amended A.R.S. § 20-893 to set forth certain criteria for non-profit military mutual aid associations including required filings and authorizing the Director of Insurance to determine an appropriate filing fee.

Licensing Requirements for Health Insurance Navigators and Health Insurance Certificated Application Counselors (Regulatory Bulletin 2014-03).

The substantive policy statement was issued June 16, 2014. The effective date of the policy statement is October 1, 2014.

3. Summary of the contents of the substantive policy statement:

This bulletin summarizes HB 2508 (Laws 2014, Ch. 153), which added a new Article 3.4 to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 20, Chapter 2, prescribing requirements for licensing of health insurance navigators and certified application counselors. Starting October 1, 2014, Arizona law requires a person to be licensed to act as a navigator or certified application counselor.
