The Board charges the following fees, which are nonrefundable unless A.R.S. § 41-1077 applies:

7. Effective September 2, 2014, a fingerprint processing fee for an initial application and completed fingerprint card, \$50.00;
8. Effective September 2, 2014, if a person did not submit fingerprints when the person was initially licensed, a finger-

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print processing fee for a person completing a fingerprint card and renewing for the first time on or after September 2, 2014;

- ~~7-9.~~ Annual registration of an approved internship, residency, clinical fellowship program, or short-term residency program, \$50;
- ~~8-10.~~ Annual teaching license at an approved school of medicine or at an approved hospital internship, residency, or clinical fellowship program, \$250;
- ~~9-11.~~ Five-day teaching permit at an approved school of medicine or at an approved hospital internship, residency, or clinical fellowship program, \$100;
- ~~10-12.~~ Copy of the annual allopathic medical directory, \$30;
- ~~11-13.~~ Initial registration to dispense drugs and devices, \$200;
- ~~12-14.~~ Annual renewal to dispense drugs and devices, \$150;
- ~~13-15.~~ Penalty fee for late renewal of an active license, \$350;
- ~~14-16.~~ Verifying a license, \$10 per request;
- ~~15-17.~~ Copies of records, documents, letters, minutes, applications, and files, \$1 for the first three pages and 25¢ for each additional page; and
