CHAPTER 11

**SENATE BILL 1005**

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 1992, CHAPTER 132, SECTION 3; AMENDING LAWS 1992, CHAPTER 132, SECTION 4, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 1994, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 1; RELATING TO THE DESERT STORM MEMORIAL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 1992, chapter 132, section 3 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 3. Desert storm memorial fund

4 A. A desert storm memorial fund is established. The fund shall  
5 consist of monies provided by appropriation or received as donations as  
6 provided by this act. The state treasurer shall invest all monies in the  
7 desert storm memorial fund and any interest earned shall be deposited into  
8 the fund. The state treasurer shall administer the fund. The monies in the  
9 fund are exempt from section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
10 lapsing of appropriations, except that any such monies remaining unexpended  
11 or unencumbered in the fund on June 30, ~~1994~~, 1997 shall revert to the state  
12 general fund.

13 B. The cost and expenses authorized by this act shall be paid for by  
14 the state treasurer from the monies available in the desert storm memorial  
15 fund upon certification to the state treasurer by the chairman of the desert  
16 storm memorial board that the amount requested is owed for a valid purpose.

17 Sec. 2. Laws 1992, chapter 132, section 4, as amended by Laws 1994,  
18 chapter 6, section 1, is amended to read:

19 Sec. 4. Termination; repeal

20 The desert storm memorial board terminates for all purposes and this  
21 act is repealed from and after December 31, ~~1995~~ 1996.

1           Sec. 3. Retroactivity  
2           A. Section 1 of this act applies retroactively to from and after June  
3           29, 1994.  
4           B. Section 2 of this act applies retroactively to from and after  
5           December 30, 1995.
