CHAPTER 15
SENATE BILL 1031

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-422, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-422, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
 3 read:

4 28-422. Licenses issued to drivers; marked licenses for persons
 5 under legal drinking age and commercial motor vehicle
 6 operators

7 A. The department shall issue to every qualifying applicant a driver's
 8 license as applied for, which shall bear thereon a distinguishing number
 9 assigned to the licensee, the license class, any endorsements, the full name,
 10 date of birth and residence address and a brief description of the licensee,
 11 and either a facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a space upon which
 12 the licensee shall write his usual signature with pen and ink. No license
 13 shall be valid until it has been so signed by the licensee. An applicant may
 14 request that a post office box address which is regularly used by the
 15 applicant and is located within the county in which the applicant resides
 16 appear on the driver's license. The department shall comply with the
 17 request.

18 B. Every application for a driver's license, and the license issued
 19 as a result of such application, shall contain the photo image of the
 20 applicant or licensee, as the case may be. The department shall use such
 21 process or processes in the issuance of licenses that prohibit as nearly as
 22 possible the ability to alter or reproduce the license or prohibit the
 23 ability to superimpose a photo image on such license without ready detection.
 24 All driver's licenses and photo images shall be processed in color. This
 25 subsection does not apply to a driver's license which is renewed by mail
 26 pursuant to section 28-426.01.

1 C. Every applicant between the ages of sixteen and twenty-three years
2 inclusive shall supply to the department satisfactory proof of his legal name
3 and date of birth.

4 D. The department shall issue a license to a qualified person under
5 the legal drinking age which has been marked, by color, code or design, so
6 as to be immediately distinguishable from a license issued to a person of
7 legal drinking age. The department shall indicate on the license the year
8 in which the person will attain the legal drinking age.

9 E. The department shall issue a license to a qualified person for a
10 class A, B or C license which has been marked as a commercial driver's
11 license or CDL.

12 F. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT INCLUDE INFORMATION IN THE MAGNETIC STRIPE
13 AND BAR CODE OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE OTHER THAN INFORMATION THAT THE DEPARTMENT
14 IS AUTHORIZED TO OBTAIN AND PLACE ON A DRIVER'S LICENSE PURSUANT TO THIS
15 ARTICLE.
