CHAPTER 150

SENATE BILL 1415

AN ACT

RELATING TO JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Joint legislative committee on children and family
3 services; additional duties

4 In addition to the duties specified by section 41-1291, subsection D,
5 Arizona Revised Statutes, the joint legislative committee on children and
6 family services shall:

7 1. Review the criteria used to determine whether reports of abuse or
8 neglect are substantiated, unsubstantiated or undetermined in both the
9 department of economic security child protective services and the department
10 of health services child care licensure unit.

11 2. Review the laws and policies governing the placement of reports of
12 abuse or neglect in department of health services and department of economic
13 security files and on the central registry.

14 3. Make recommendations to the president of the senate, the speaker
15 of the house of representatives and members of the senate family services
16 committee and the house of representatives human services committee by
17 November 1, 1996.

18 Sec. 2. Repeal

19 Section 1 of this act is repealed from and after January 1, 1997.
