CHAPTER 187

SENATE BILL 1382

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 23, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 23-792; RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT SECURITY BENEFITS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 23, chapter 4, article 6, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 23-792, to read:

4 23-792. School bus contractors with educational institutions:
5 definition

6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, BENEFITS BASED ON SERVICE BY A
7 SCHOOL BUS CONTRACTOR FOR AN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SHALL NOT BE PAID TO AN
8 INDIVIDUAL FOR ANY WEEK OF UNEMPLOYMENT THAT BEGINS DURING A PERIOD BETWEEN
9 TWO SUCCESSIVE ACADEMIC YEARS OR TERMS IF THE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMS THESE
10 SERVICES IN THE FIRST OF THE SUCCESSIVE ACADEMIC YEARS OR TERMS AND IF THERE
11 IS A REASONABLE ASSURANCE THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WILL PERFORM THE SAME SERVICES
12 IN THE SECOND OF THE SUCCESSIVE ACADEMIC YEARS OR TERMS, EXCEPT THAT IF
13 BENEFITS ARE DENIED TO ANY INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AND THAT
14 INDIVIDUAL WAS NOT OFFERED AN OPPORTUNITY TO PERFORM THESE SERVICES FOR THE
15 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION FOR THE SECOND SUCCESSIVE ACADEMIC YEAR OR TERM, THE
16 INDIVIDUAL IS ENTITLED TO A RETROACTIVE PAYMENT OF BENEFITS FOR EACH WEEK FOR
17 WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL FILED A TIMELY CLAIM FOR BENEFITS AND THE BENEFITS WERE
18 DENIED SOLELY BY REASON OF THIS SUBSECTION.

1 B. BENEFITS BASED ON SERVICE BY A SCHOOL BUS CONTRACTOR FOR AN
2 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION SHALL NOT BE PAID TO AN INDIVIDUAL FOR ANY WEEK OF
3 UNEMPLOYMENT THAT BEGINS DURING AN ESTABLISHED AND CUSTOMARY VACATION PERIOD
4 OR HOLIDAY RECESS IF THE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMS THESE SERVICES IN THE PERIOD
5 IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE VACATION PERIOD OR HOLIDAY RECESS AND IF THERE IS A
6 REASONABLE ASSURANCE THAT THE INDIVIDUAL WILL PERFORM THE SERVICES IN THE
7 PERIOD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE VACATION PERIOD OR HOLIDAY RECESS.

8 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL BUS" HAS THE SAME MEANING
9 AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 28-101.

11 This act is effective from and after December 31, 1996.
