CHAPTER 208

**HOUSE BILL 2193**

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR PROCUREMENT CODE EXCEPTIONS FOR THE STATE PARKS BOARD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Procurement code; exemption; Kartchner  
3 Caverns state park

4 A. The state parks board is exempt from the provisions of sections  
5 41-2533, 41-2534, 41-2535, 41-2572, 41-2573, 41-2576, 41-2577 and 41-2578,  
6 Arizona Revised Statutes, for the selection of contractors for the design and  
7 construction of the primary and support structures and utilities within the  
8 Kartchner Caverns state park.

9 B. After consultation with the director of the department of  
10 administration or the director's designee, the state parks board shall  
11 publish and use competitive procedures for the selection of the contractors.  
12 The competitive procedures shall include determination of evaluation  
13 criteria, shall require the board to negotiate fees that are reasonable and  
14 shall require the board to consult with the director of the department of  
15 administration or the director's designee before awarding any contract  
16 pursuant to this act.

17 C. The state parks board is exempt from the remainder of title 41,  
18 chapter 23, Arizona Revised Statutes, if both of the following apply:

19 1. The state parks board submits a written waiver request to the  
20 director of the department of administration.

21 2. The director of the department of administration determines in  
22 writing that the waiver is necessary for the timely completion of the  
23 Kartchner Caverns state park and is in this state's best interest.

1           Sec. 2. Delayed repeal  
2           This act is repealed from and after June 30, 1999.  
3           Sec. 3. Emergency  
4           This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the  
5 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by  
6 law.
