## CHAPTER 221

**SENATE BILL 1010**

## AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 2-364 AND 41-1533, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; REPEALING SECTION 41-1534, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO JOINT LEGISLATIVE MILITARY AIRPORT REUSE COMMITTEE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 2-364, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
 3 read:

4 2-364. Joint legislative military airport reuse committee;  
 5 annual report

6 A. If a joint powers airport authority is established pursuant to law,  
 7 the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives  
 8 shall establish a joint legislative MILITARY airport reuse ~~of closed military~~  
 9 ~~facilities~~ committee consisting of the following members:

10 ~~1. The chairpersons of the house of representatives committees on~~  
 11 ~~transportation, ways and means and commerce or their successor committees.~~

12 ~~2. The chairpersons of the senate committees on transportation,~~  
 13 ~~finance and commerce and economic development or their successor committees.~~

14 ~~3.~~ 1. Five FOUR members of the senate who are appointed by the  
 15 president of the senate, ~~three~~ TWO of whom are members of the minority party.

16 ~~4.~~ 2. Five FOUR members of the house of representatives who are  
 17 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, ~~three~~ TWO of whom  
 18 are members of the minority party.

1 B. A joint powers airport authority that is established pursuant to  
2 law shall submit a written report annually to the joint legislative MILITARY  
3 airport reuse ~~of closed military facilities~~ committee established by this  
4 section. The airport authority shall submit the first report on the date  
5 that is one year after the date the airport authority is established. The  
6 report shall describe the activities of the airport authority.

7 C. The joint legislative MILITARY airport reuse ~~of closed military~~  
8 ~~facilities~~ committee shall:

9 1. Select a chairperson from among its members.

10 2. Meet at least once each year and at additional times on the call  
11 of the chairperson or a majority of its members.

12 3. Review the report submitted pursuant to subsection B.

13 4. Make recommendations to the president of the senate, the speaker  
14 of the house of representatives, THE GOVERNOR, LOCAL AUTHORITIES and the  
15 board of directors of the joint powers airport authority to assist in the  
16 reuse of closed military facilities in this state.

17 5. REVIEW THE ANNUAL REPORT FOR EACH MILITARY REUSE ZONE SUBMITTED BY  
18 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 41-1533 AND CONSIDER THE  
19 CONDITIONS, PROGRESS AND OUTLOOK OF EACH MILITARY REUSE ZONE IN THIS STATE.

20 Sec. 2. Section 41-1533, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

21 41-1533. Duties of department of commerce

22 The department shall administer this article and shall:

23 1. Monitor the implementation and operation of this article and  
24 continually evaluate the progress made in the military reuse zone.

25 2. Assist an employer or prospective employer in a zone to obtain the  
26 benefits of any incentive authorized by this article.

27 3. Submit an annual written report to the governor and to the JOINT  
28 legislative ~~oversight~~ MILITARY AIRPORT REUSE committee established by section  
29 ~~41-1534~~ 2-364 evaluating the effectiveness of the program with respect to  
30 each zone, stating the amount of foregone tax revenue due to the incentives  
31 offered pursuant to section 41-1532, reporting any abuses and presenting any  
32 suggestions to improve the program. The report is due on or before March 1,  
33 beginning in the first full calendar year after the zone is established and  
34 ending in the first full calendar year after the zone is terminated.

35 4. Adopt rules as necessary to administer this article.

36 5. Provide information regarding military reuse zones on request and  
37 conduct informational and instructional seminars and training.

38 Sec. 3. Repeal

39 Section 41-1534, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
