CHAPTER 222

SENATE BILL 1102

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 37, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-3720; RELATING TO MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 37, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 by adding section 13-3720, to read:

4 13-3720. Tattoos; minors; violation; classification; definition

5 A. IT IS UNLAWFUL TO TATTOO A PERSON WHO IS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF
6 AGE WITHOUT THE PHYSICAL PRESENCE OF THAT PERSON'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.

7 B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 6 FELONY.

8 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "TATTOO" MEANS ANY INDELIBLE
9 DESIGN, LETTER, SCROLL, FIGURE, SYMBOL OR ANY OTHER MARK PLACED UPON OR UNDER
10 THE SKIN WITH INK OR COLORS BY THE AID OF NEEDLES OR OTHER INSTRUMENTS THAT
11 CANNOT BE REMOVED WITHOUT A SURGICAL PROCEDURE OR ANY DESIGN, LETTER, SCROLL,
12 FIGURE OR SYMBOL DONE BY SCARRING UPON OR UNDER THE SKIN.
