CHAPTER 227

HOUSE BILL 2100

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 5-502, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE STATE LOTTERY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 5-502, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 5-502. Arizona state lottery commission; membership;
5 appointment; term; chairman; removal; reimbursement of
6 expenses

7 A. There is established the Arizona state lottery commission
8 consisting of five members who shall be citizens and residents of this state
9 and appointed by the governor pursuant to section 38-211. No more than three
10 members may be from the same political party. The term of members appointed
11 to the commission is five years. ~~Initial appointments to the commission~~
12 ~~shall be made within thirty days of the effective date of this chapter.~~ The
13 commission members shall annually elect one of the members to serve as
14 chairman of the commission.

15 B. At least one member of the commission shall have a minimum of five
16 years' experience in law enforcement.

17 C. At least one member of the commission shall have a minimum of five
18 years' experience as a certified public accountant.

19 D. At least one member of the commission shall have a minimum of five
20 years' experience in marketing or advertising, or both.

21 E. AT LEAST ONE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM OF FIVE
22 YEARS' EXPERIENCE IN CONVENIENCE STORE, MINIMART OR GROCERY RETAILING.

1 ~~E~~ F. Any member of the commission may be removed from office by the
2 governor for cause upon notice and opportunity to be heard at a public
3 hearing.

4 ~~F~~ G. Members of the commission are eligible to receive compensation
5 pursuant to section 38-611.

6 ~~G~~ H. The commission shall hold at least one meeting each quarter.

7 ~~H~~ I. No commission member may have a pecuniary interest in any
8 contract or agreement to which the commission is a party.

9 ~~I~~ J. No action of the commission is binding unless taken at a
10 meeting with at least three members present voting in favor of the action in
11 question.

12 Sec. 2. Retention of members

13 Notwithstanding section 5-502, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by
14 this act, all persons serving as members of the Arizona state lottery
15 commission on the effective date of this act may continue to serve until the
16 expiration of their normal terms. The governor shall make all subsequent
17 appointments as prescribed by statute.
