HOUSE BILL 2179

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-1591.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO VEHICLE LICENSE TAX.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-1591.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
3 to read:

4 28-1591.01. License tax exemption for certain veterans:
5 limitations

6 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 28-1591, no license tax
7 shall be collected from a veteran residing in this state for a vehicle or any
8 replacement of ~~such~~ THE vehicle acquired by financial aid from the veterans'
9 administration pursuant to the provisions of Public Laws 79-663, 85-56,
10 85-857, 90-77, 91-666 and 93-538 (38 ~~USCA~~ UNITED STATES CODE sections 1901
11 through 1988), as amended.

12 B. No license tax or registration fee shall be collected from any
13 veteran for a personally owned vehicle or from a veteran and another party
14 owning a vehicle if ~~such~~ THE veteran is certified by the veterans'
15 administration to be one hundred per cent disabled and drawing compensation
16 on that basis. If a veteran is certified pursuant to this subsection, on the
17 INITIAL registration of ~~such~~ THE vehicle or on the replacement of ~~such~~ THE
18 vehicle with a personally owned vehicle or a vehicle owned by the veteran and
19 another party, a veteran need only present a signed, sworn notarized
20 statement affirming that the veteran is eligible to receive the exemption
21 granted by this subsection.

1 C. A veteran claiming an exemption prescribed by this section shall
2 ON INITIAL REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE present satisfactory proof of ~~such~~ THE
3 veterans' administration financial aid or government compensation and
4 certificate on determination of one hundred per cent disability, as
5 applicable. ~~Such~~ THE exemption may be claimed and granted for only one
6 vehicle or any replacement of ~~such~~ THE vehicle owned by ~~such~~ THE veteran.
